By-law Number 119 - 2020

A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw Number 80-2006, Being a Bylaw to Administer Business Licensing for the City of Kenora

Whereas Council adopted a bylaw to authorize the issuance of certain licenses and regulations for business licensing in the City of Kenora on June 12, 2006; and

Whereas Council approved amendments to the Outdoor Commercial Patio Policy (2012) recognizing that as Ontario gradually reopens the economy following the COVID-19 pandemic, there will need to be supportive policy in place for businesses that will seek to operate with restrictions in place; and

Whereas since that time, there has been considerable interest in pursuing patio development while using adjacent municipal property to maximize occupancy which includes interest to have vending stations for food production and/or sales; and

Whereas under Business Licensing Bylaw 80-2006 such uses are prohibited unless for the purpose of a special event;

Now Therefore be it Resolved That Council hereby amends section 15, Exception to read as follows:

1. Exception:

The restrictions contained above in clause i) and clause ii) a, b, and c, do not apply if at any time the selling or offering for sale of any goods, wares or foods is approved under a License of Occupation for 2020 or located within an area being used for the holding of a fair, exhibition, festival, celebration or other public gathering or special occasion authorized by the Corporation of the City of Kenora, and that prior approval has been obtained from the approved event organizers for the vendor to participate at such event(s).

This regulation includes but is not limited to refreshment vehicles, hawkers and/or peddlers, whether they are licensed or not under this or any by-law.

2. That all other sections, including other amendments, remain in effect.
