By-Law Number 10 - 2022

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2022

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2022 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 150-2021 on December 21, 2021; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held February 8, 2022 Council recommended a budget amendment in the amount of \$789,437 to be funded through Municipal Accommodation Tax (MAT) revenues for the delivery of the 2022 MAT Program; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment in the amount of \$789,437 to be funded through Municipal Accommodation Tax (MAT) revenues for the delivery of the 2022 MAT Program.
- 2. That the 2022 Municipal Capital Budget be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
