Being a By-Law to Repeal By-Law Number 135-2021

Whereas Council adopted bylaw #135-2021 being a bylaw to authorize a license of occupation agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Her Majesty the Queen, in Right of Canada, represented by the Minister of the Environment for the use of property located at the intersection of Bay Street and Government Road (North-East corner), City of Kenora, in the Province of Ontario; and
