By-Law Number 2 - 2023

A By-Law to Authorize an Amendment to a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada as Represented by the Minister of Economic Development and Official Languages (FedNor) for the McLeod Park and Husky's Landing Improvement Project

Whereas on December 21, 2021 Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora authorized the execution of a funding agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada as Represented by the Minister of Economic Development and Official Languages (FedNor) for the construction and refurbishment of McLeod Park and Husky's Landing; and

Whereas on October 25, 2022, Council authorized an amendment to that project agreement to reflect the completion date of January 31, 2023; and

Whereas it has been deemed necessary to make further amendments to the agreement to adjust cost categories to more accurately reflect expenses and amend the contribution agreement;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. That authorization be given for the City of Kenora to amend the funding agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada as Represented by the Minister of Economic Development and Official Languages (FedNor) for the construction and refurbishment of McLeod Park and Husky's Landing.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and are hereby authorized to execute the amending Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
