## The Corporation of the City of Kenora By-law Number 70 - 2025

## A By-Law to Repeal the Appointment of a Tax Collector

**Whereas** pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, c.25, s.285 (1) the City Treasurer is entrusted with the responsibility for managing all financial matters of the municipality; and further

**Whereas** Subsection 285 (2) affirms that Deputy Treasurers possess the full scope of powers and responsibilities equivalent to the Treasurer; and

**Whereas** the office of the Tax Collector has become vacant and the responsibilities have been reassigned to a new position of Tax and Assessment Officer which will be managed within the existing administrative framework by the City Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers;

**Now Therefore** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora ("the Corporation") enacts as follows:

- 1. That bylaw number 29-2019 be hereby repealed.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passage hereof.
