A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2025

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2025 Five Year Capital Plan budget by passing By-law Number 145-2024 on November 19, 2025 and

Whereas at a Regular Council meeting held May 20, 2025 Council supported a budget amendment to proceed with the award of the MCSC Lobby & General Improvements project; and

Whereas Council authorized an amendment to the 2023 Capital Budget in an amount up to \$395,000 to proceed with the award of the MCSC Lobby & General Improvements project, funded by surplus budget from the MCSC Rink Slab Replacement project and Recreation Facilities reserve; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 160-2022:

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- That Council hereby authorizes a 2023 capital budget amendment in the amount of \$395,000 funded by the surplus budget from the rink slab replacement project and recreation reserves to advance the award of the Moncrief Construction Sports Centre Lobby & General Improvements project.
- 2. That the 2023 Five Year Capital Plan Budget be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
