## **By-law Number 86 - 2025**

## A By-law to amend By-law Number 169-2024 a Bylaw To Establish and Regulate Parking Lots and Structures Within the City of Kenora

Whereas Council adopted By-law Number 169-2024 on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 2024 which establishes and regulates Parking Lots and Structures in the City of Kenora, in accordance with the Municipal Act, with respect to parking in municipal parking lots and structures; and

Whereas Council deems it necessary and expedient to amend Bylaw Number 169-2024 to establish a monthly parking lot and rate for July and August plus applicable taxes for temporary long-term parking at 80 Government Road "Former Keewatin Public Works Yard" to accommodate some of the seasonal overflow parking at the Bowman Electric Keewatin Memorial Arena as well as alleviate some of the on-street parking burden in Keewatin during the summer months; and

Whereas Council deems it necessary and expedient to amend Bylaw Number 169-2024 to establish 80 Government Road as a temporary seasonal long-term parking lot with monthly parking rate fees; and

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Parking Lot Fees & Regulations be amended with the following:

**80 Government Road Parking Lot** 

**Control:** By-Law Enforcement Officer

City Designated Towing Company (at owner's expense)

**Fees:** Monthly: \$132.74 plus applicable taxes

**Special Regulation:** Vehicles in excess of 6.7 metres permitted

July and August Only

- 2. That this by-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
- **3.** That this bylaw shall expire on September 1, 2025.
