By-Law 152 - 2025

A By-Law to Execute A Lease Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Ontario Public Service Employees Union (OPSEU) for Unit A located at 1008 Ottawa Street

Whereas the Ontario Public Service Employees Union (OPSEU) leases municipal property known as Unit A, 1008 Ottawa Street in the City of Kenora; and

Whereas a lease Agreement was executed between the City of Kenora and the Ontario Public Service Employees Union (OPSEU) for a five-year term under By-law 112-2017 which expired September 2022; and

Whereas OPSEU has been occupying the space on a month-to-month tenancy since this date and OPSEU have requested a by-law be passed to validate an agreement to June 30, 2026; and

Whereas an agreement has been reached with the Ontario Public Service Employees Union (OPSEU) for this purpose;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. That approval is hereby given to enter into a lease agreement with the Ontario Public Service Employees Union (OPSEU) for property located at Unit A at 1008 Ottawa Street for a term ending June 30, 2026.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute the lease agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement attached to this By-law and affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
