8. Detachment Commander's Report – Resolution #4

That the Kenora Police Services Board hereby accepts the Kenora OPP monthly reports for the month of September and October 2020 as presented.

Discussion: Festive ride season we did receive the grant. The grant we can use all year. Had a meeting recently with Chamber and BIZ and officers will be on foot patrol with the downtown shopping.

COVID reopening calls for service –we are getting a few calls for over capacity and not wearing masks. Doing joint inspections and presence with the NWHU. The NWHU is going over what their capacities are, logs and screening. COVID in the OPP station they have segregated work spaces and have plexi glass in the offices, washing hands, sanitizing. Going through a lot of masks. Have had some employees off due to self isolation for exposure. Some have had exposure through kids and spouses who have had to self isolate and following direction of NWHU. Doctor on staff who works for the OPP and he is following direction.

Full launch November 2nd are on the street 4 days and the youth team works four days. Once we have a full months of stats for them he will report and provide numbers for them. It will give them two life span teams, mobile team and youth team. That will improve significantly.

Brief mental health screener report but there was an error in the report so need to get corrected and will bring to next meeting.

The policing annual costs 6,379,854.00 Jeff will do everything he can to get that cost down. Want to ensure when the city gets the bill the cost is realistic for service. The costs are a four year floating average so will not realize the reduction in calls for service this year until 2023. Hoping to keep the calls for service at this years level. Some of the island crimes are up, but the regular calls for service are down.

There will be a mental health professional in the communication centre and hoping the caller can work with the mental health professional on the phone and police won't have to respond to those calls at all. It will get transferred to the mental health professional and

the dispatcher will stay on the line. If it can't be resolved the police would be dispatched, so anticipating a reduction in calls for service.

Detachment Commander Duggan reviewed the statistical report.

There are many positive highlights from the report which partnerships and programs that are being implemented are working. There is a new program being launched in Pikanjikum that will assist with the residents of that First Nations having support in their own community.

Calls for service year to date are down 2,287 calls for service. Hope to see the calls keep declining with all the new programs and supports.

Good resource on OPP.ca site. It has all communities and property counts and their policing costs and comparing similar communities in size. Orillia detachment has 100 officers, we have 80 and calls for service are about the same. Because of geography its hard to compare apples to apples.

Staffing there are some pending retirements and restructuring. By end of year there will be five vacancies in the detachment. They are working with the OPP for recruitment and they are filling the vacancies based on front line service.
