Call to Order

Pregnancy & Infant Loss Network (PAIL)

Heather Morton-Ricard along with Kristen Patrick and Andrea Clemmens are part of the peer support volunteers from the Pregnancy & Infant Loss Network of Ontario (PAIL). PAIL provides support and education for families who have experienced a loss either during pregnancy or within the first year of their child's life. Each volunteer has gone through their own experience with this type of loss firsthand, which is why they decided to undergo training and are eager to bring a circle of support to Kenora and surrounding areas. They want to close the large gap that exists in the community by supporting parents and families touched by these extremely heartbreaking and fairly common losses. Their plan is to offer monthly meetings which will include an opportunity for sharing, support, and connection within our local loss community. They also will continue to hold their annual Pregnancy & Infant Loss Awareness event on or close to October 15th each year. Their work as volunteers does not allow for many expenses.

The group is requesting Council to waive the fees for the monthly support group meetings at the Kenora Recreation Centre as well as the PAIL Awareness Day event to ensure this important support group continues in the community.

Garrow Park Playground Cover Material

Whereas Council authorized a budget amendment to withdraw funds from the Accessibility Reserve in the amount of \$75,000 to offset the cost of this work; and

Whereas the Accessibility Advisory Committee has met further to discuss the limited funds available for addressing accessibility issues within the community;

Now Therefore let it be Resolved That Council directs administration to put a hold on the direction that was provided to administration at the July 17, 2018 Council meeting to replace the engineered wood fibre (EWF) with artificial turf, to allow the Accessibility Advisory Committee time to review options and establish priorities.
