Total number of calls for service in March were 1,414, April 1,490 and May 1,769.

May month end report demonstrates that sexual assaults are going down. There are increases in property crime which are a direct result of the drug problem that is occurring primarily driven by methamphetamine. There is a reduction is stolen goods and an increase in fraud.

In this guarter, there was an overall drop in crime at around 7%.

Traffic enforcement has been stepped up and the volume of traffic enforcement tickets are being processed.

Sara requested stats on mental health calls at the last meeting and Paul will check with Bob Bernie if these statistics have been developed and ready for distribution to board.
