# Presentations/Deputations

## **Presentation of the Service Delivery Review – Optimus SBR**

Michelle Lenarduzzi, Mariam Ali of Optimus SBR presented the findings and overview of the service delivery review.

The project mission was to undertake a comprehensive service delivery review of City of Kenora to evaluate how services are currently being delivered and identify opportunities to strengthen service delivery effectiveness and efficiency.

Each service had a detailed current state assessment conducted that was refined and updated when the project resumed. For each service we have developed key recommendations, based on our understanding of the current state. Recommendations were developed and validated to ensure they align with operating realities and are actionable.

There were 13 services selected for a detailed review and recommendations development. The focus area for each is outlined as it aligns to the SDR Framework. Based on the current state City-wide themes there were overarching recommendations developed.

The final report has been designed to include information for each recommendation:

- An overview of Current State findings that precipitated the recommendation;
- Detailed information related to the proposed recommendation;

• An overview of the financial impact, including the main cost drivers for the City for each recommendation and implementation considerations to support next steps planning; and,

• A summary of benefits if the recommendation is adopted.

In addition to the content provided for each recommendation, the report is designed to act as a standalone document, containing:

- The final current state report; and,
- Implementation and prioritization considerations for the City

An implementation strategy was included and recommendations for the City on implementation of the recommendations.

Council thanked Optimus SDR for the presentation and a copy was left with the Clerk.
