### 2. Urgent Item – Request for Change to Funding Support

Chair Ashley Nordlund advised the committee that she received an email yesterday from Science North regarding registration numbers for the Summit event and the need to cancel. They still want to engage students in Kenora in climate action, and so instead throughout the week they will be running in-school programs for schools around the community. The Sustainability Advisory Committee had agreed to support the Summit with high school students running a pitch it campaign. The committee agreed to donate up to \$500 to the pitch it campaign.

They will be at St. Louis Living Arts school all day delivering climate change programming and they will be working with their EcoTeam as part of EcoSchools Canada. Recognizing that the \$500 donation from committee was for the summit, any change in the direction of the committee must be supported by the committee.
