Minutes

of a Meeting of the Council of the City of Kenora held Monday, October 28, 2002 – City Chambers at 5:00 p.m.

WITH Mayor D. Canfield in the Chair, Councillor R. Lunny, Councillor D. McDougald, Councillor R. McMillan, Councillor T. Szajewski, Councillor C. Wasacase, Joanne L. McMillin, City Clerk.

Absent: Councillor I. Parkes

Mayor Canfield called the meeting to order and Councillor Szajewski read the Prayer.

CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

1.Moved by T. Szajewski, Seconded by C. Wasacase & Carried:-

THAT the Minutes of the last Regular Meeting of Council of the City of Kenora held October **15**, **2002**, be confirmed as written and circulated.

Mayor Canfield then asked if any Member of Council had any Declarations of Interest with respect to any items on the Agenda. The following Declarations were made:- Councillor McDougald – Resolution No. 4.

DEPUTATIONS:

<u>Wavne Beckworth – Main Street Traffic Plan</u>

Mr. Beckworth questioned if there were any signed Engineering drawings for the design of the Main Street Traffic Plan? Mr. Spencer confirmed that the City Engineering Office assisted in the preparation of the Option "C" Plan.

Mr. Beckworth explained that he along with another 18 of 22 downtown businesses are very upset with the Traffic Plan, and also that the downtown Merchants had little or no knowledge that this Plan was going to be put in place so quickly and without their input. He noted the Harbourtown Centre Committee never approached the businesses and he doesn't believe this group represents the Downtown Merchants. Mr. Beckworth also noted that various Emergency Services were not contacted for their input, and mentioned that the Kenora Police Services is not in favour of the plan, yet Council still proceeded with it's implementation.

Reference was made to the suggestion that Merchants would have to open their doors at 7:30 a.m. for their deliveries and Mr. Beckworth indicated that businesses cannot afford the wages to do so. Further he explained this plan has had a negative affect on his business during the last week.

The loss of parking meters is a concern to Mr. Beckworth and he noted that vehicles are parking in the middle of the road and double-parked to make deliveries, which makes it impossible for patrons to shop downtown. Customers continue to complain about the poor parking in the downtown area. Mr. Beckworth would like to see more parking spots created than the ones we have eliminated.

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Mr. Beckworth advised he has submitted a petition to Bill Preisentanz of those against the parking plan.

Councillor McMillan responded to Mr. Beckworth with his point of view stating that the City must address and resolve all issues that arise out of the implementation of this plan, and in reviewing the plan, include the public's views as part of the evaluation.

Councillor McMillan believes that as a Council, we need to learn from this issue and to do a much better job in communicating our direction and our plans to the citizens of our city. He also explained that we need to move forward and take what we have learned from this as we address upcoming projects.

Mayor Canfield responded that this Plan is on a trial basis only at this time and is subject to change. Mayor Canfield also explained that this is a very open Council and we would welcome any comments from anyone on how to better improve the Traffic Plan if this one isn't working.

Mr. Beckworth suggested the City hold an open forum with the public, businesses and Emergency Services to assist in improving the Traffic Plan.
