Take Notice that as required under Notice By-law No. 14-2003, Council hereby advises the public of its intention to amend the 2003 Municipal Budget by adopting the following by-law at its September 8 meeting:-

- 1) To amend the 2003 Capital Fund Budget by appropriating funds from the Infrastructure/Planning Reserve Fund to an upset limit of \$27,000 for the Downtown Streetscape Study;
- 2) To amend the 2003 Capital Fund Budget for the Public Works Yard Relocation by increasing the cost estimate to \$9,300,000 with a net cost of \$7,800,000 and appropriating funds from the Engineering Project Reserve Fund in the amount of \$150,000, the Engineering Reserve Fund in the amount of \$100,000 and the Public Works Building Keewatin Reserve Fund in the amount of \$25,000 to offset the costs of this project.
