WITH Mayor D. Canfield in the Chair, Councillor R. Lunny, Councillor D. McDougald, Councillor R. McMillan, Councillor, I. Parkes Councillor T. Szajewski, Councillor C. Wasacase, Bill Preisentanz, CAO, Paulette M. Grouda, Deputy City Clerk.

DEPUTATION

<u> Matt Schaaf – Christian Peacemaker Teams</u>

Mr. Schaaf appeared before Council to advise of the work being done by the CPT on behalf of Grassy Narrows in maintaining a violence reduction team at the blockade of the logging roads in the area of Grassy Narrows. CPT is affiliated with 5000 churches in Canada and United States. Their role here is to watch over the blockade and resolve conflict with no violence and to bring awareness to the Non native people. Mr. Schaaf circulated an information pamphlet and a Non Native "Treaty" card to those present.

Rodger Wilcott

Mr. Wilcott is part of a delegation from the United States and will be taking the message back to the Quakers as to what is happening in this area regarding the Grassy Narrows situation.

Mayor Canfield advised there would be no violence. Mayor Canfield also advised of the structure of Common Land Common Ground which was formed by the Grand Chief and the Mayor three years ago and that this process will continue to work at getting everyone to the table to resolve issues and move forward collectively.
