Mayor Canfield called the meeting to order and Councillor McMillan read the Prayer.

<u>CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES</u> 1.Moved by C. Wasacase, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

THAT the Minutes of the last Regular Meeting of Council of the City of Kenora held **Monday, January 12, 2004** be confirmed as written and circulated.

Emily Tacknyk-Roulston

Ms Tacknyk-Roulston requested a report from those Members of Council, specifically Councillor Poirier as Operations Chair, upon return from the Ontario Good Roads Conference taking place in Toronto next month. She questioned what 'roads projects' are taking place in southern Ontario that requires the funding to remain in that part of the province rather than here as there is no money being provided to Northwestern Ontario for road projects. In closing she asked if there was "northern" representation on the OGRA Board of Directors, and Mayor Canfield advised there are two representatives.

2004 Five Year Capital Plan 9. Moved by L. Compton, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

THAT the City of Kenora 2004 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan as reviewed and amended by the Budget Committee be approved.

<u>Pinecrest Home – Request Vacant Beds be Re-opened</u> 10. Moved by A. Poirier, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

WHEREAS the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care made a ruling in 2003 not to re-open a number of long-term beds as they become vacant at the Kenora and District Home for the Aged (Pinecrest) in Kenora; and

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WHEREAS there is an unprecedented need by senior citizens in the Kenora District and First Nations Communities to have these long-term beds reopened so that seniors may remain in their own environment and receive proper care at a reasonable cost; and

WHEREAS other health care facilities, such as the Lake of the Woods District Hospital is filled to capacity with patients that require the extended long-term care exclusively available at nursing homes; and

WHEREAS the daily costs associated with seniors remaining in hospital care versus Homes for the Aged is exorbitant comparatively and the permanent care that seniors require is underprovided due in part that hospitals are not long-term care facilities; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care in projecting the need for additional long-term care beds have ignored the area north and west of Sudbury;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Kenora hereby implores the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care to re-open 30 long-term care beds that are sitting empty at the Kenora and District Home for the Aged which are in high demand and a vital necessity to senior citizens in our area; and

THAT the Kenora District Municipal Association, an advocacy on behalf of municipalities in the Kenora District of Northwestern Ontario, be requested to petition the Province, demanding that it is imperative for the unoccupied long-term care beds at Pinecrest Home be re-instated immediately; and further

THAT a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Honourable Dalton McGuinty, Premier of Ontario, the Honourable George Smitherman, Minister of Health and Long-Term Care, the Honourable John Gerretsen, Minister Responsible for Seniors, and the Honourable Howard Hampton, MPP, for direct action on this critical issue on behalf of senior citizens in this part of the province.

<u>CRF Allocations</u> 11.Moved by R. McMillan, Seconded by C. Wasacase & Carried:-

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WHEREAS Council prefers the Standing Committee Structure which allows for a more thorough review of the many items they must resolve with the input of staff at such meetings;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Kenora hereby agrees to disband the Committee of the Whole Structure and to adopt a Governance Model with the use of the six (6) Standing Committees with recommendations referred to meetings of the Council; and

THAT the City Clerk be directed to prepare a revised Procedural By-law to reflect the new Governance Model with an implementation date of March 1, 2004; and further

THAT notice is hereby given in accordance with Notice By-law #14-2003 that a new Procedural By-law will be adopted at a meeting of Council to be held Monday, February 23, 2004.
