Call to Order

Acting Mayor Wasacase called the meeting to order and Councillor Compton read the Prayer.

CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

Don Kinger

Referred to the amount of remuneration, expenses, and daily per diems being claimed by Members of Council on travel and he believes these amounts are excessive. He also commented that it appears the same Members are always traveling, and questioned whether travel isn't done on a rotating basis? Further he suggested that Members with knowledge in a specific area of interest do not appear to be traveling to meetings that relate to their expertise rather it seems that Members who may not be that familiar with the particular subject matter are attending.

Bert Alcock

Referred to snow and ice control and the potential for the City having to pay out settlements for salt contamination, noting the City should be in touch with its Solicitor to demand the Ministry of Transportation recognize the problem and pay for it. Mr. Alcock urged Council to take this up with MTO as soon as possible; not only for the environmental concern, but that it has the potential to be very costly to the City of Kenora.

In closing, Mr. Alcock commended Council on its initiative to establish and appoint a Municipal Audit Committee.
