Take Notice that as required under Notice By-law No. 14-2003, Council intends to adopt the following by-laws at the May 10 Council meeting:

- To authorize the sale of 1304 Ninth Street North (Castle of Learning Day Care Centre) to Kenora Anishinaabe-Kweg Aboriginal Women's Organization;
- To amend the 2004 Capital Budget to provide for changes to include the Highway 17 East Improvements Project, and to remove the 7th Avenue South Bridge Project and the Bridge Inventory Studies to the 2006 Capital Budget with funding from the Kenora Roads Reserve Fund;
- To authorize the sale of a municipal lot on 18th Avenue North described as Plan M103, Lot 74;
 - To name a portion of transferred roadway to the City of Kenora as "Beauty Bay Road"

described as: part of remainder of Parcel 16202, Part of Lot 1, Concession 1 of the Township of Melick, described as Parts 2 and 3 on Plan 23R-4501, now City of Kenora.
