# <u>Finance & Administration</u>

- ~ Approval of Accounts Listings.
- ~ Council will introduce a motion urging municipalities in the Kenora District to petition the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care with respect to land ambulance services cost.
- ~ Approval will be given to adopt a by-law to establish claw back rates for certain property classes.

- ~ Council will authorize an amendment to the municipal budget in order to fund additional municipal policing costs.
- ~ The 2005 KMTS stipend will be referred to the operating budget for consideration.
- ~ Council will introduce a motion petitioning the Province to revoke its Regulation with respect to municipal clerks performing civil marriages.
- ~ Council will give three readings to a by-law authorizing the entering into of an agreement with the Ministry of Transportation regarding dedicated gas tax funds for public transportation.
