City of Kenora as Land Ambulance Providers: Warren F. Brinkman investigated this matter. According to a Ministry of Health Manager, this is possible if the Kenora District Services Board "subcontracted" their present Land Ambulance Provider agreement to the City. For example, the City of Sault Ste Marie, through contract with the District Services Board, presently provides Land Ambulance Services to its constituents. The Sault Ste. Marie Fire Service administers this contract. The Emergency Service Committee for the City of Kenora is not interested in pursuing this concept at this time.
