

# Minutes

Of a Meeting of the Council of the City of Kenora Tuesday, May 23, 2006 – City Council Chambers 5:00 p.m.

#### Call to Order

A/Mayor McMillan called the meeting to order and Councillor Wasacase read the Prayer.

#### Public Information NOTICES as per By-law Number 14-2003

A/Mayor McMillan then read the following notices: -

As required under Notice By-law No. 14-2003, Council hereby advises the public of its intention to adopt the following by-laws at tonight's meeting:-

- To amend Comprehensive Traffic By-law and to adopt a new Parking Lots By-law to provide for increases in metered parking and parking lots rates, effective June 1, 2006;
- To increase the Set Fines Schedule to Comprehensive Traffic By-law #127-2001;
- To adopt the 2006 Water & Sewer Operating Budget & Five Year Capital Plan;
- To adopt the 2006 Solid Waste Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan;
- To amend the 2006 Operating Budget to authorize an appropriation in the amount of \$61,333.18 from the Tax Rebates/Write Offs Reserve;
- To adopt a new Parking Lots By-law to provide for increases in parking lot rates, effective June 1, 2006;
- To establish a special Post Secondary Summer Student Membership Rate for the Kenora Recreation Centre.

# **Confirmation of Minutes**

THAT the Minutes of the last Regular Meeting of the Council of the City of Kenora held **Monday**, **May 8**, **2006** be confirmed as written and circulated.

THAT the Reports dated **May 11, 2006** of the Finance and Administration Committee, submitting for approval and authorization for payment, invoices, accounts and payroll summaries, including transfers to Boards and Commissions for municipal and utility listings, totalling **\$2,349,894.59** be hereby authorized for approval.

# 3. Moved by T. Szajewski, Seconded by C. Wasacase & Carried:-

THAT Council of the City of Kenora hereby undertake the following steps by July 31, 2006 with respect to addressing the forecasted funding deficit for 2007 and beyond:-

- 1. adopt the May 2006 Terms of Reference for the Operational Review of City departments;
- direct administration to provide a report on the Municipal Performance Measurement Program (MPMP) comparing costs and level of performance of municipal services both internally, year to year, and externally among municipalities;
- 3. undertake a joint review with the Kenora Police Services Board of police service delivery for the City of Kenora with a view to deciding on one police force or maintaining the current two police force model;
- 4. direct administration to provide a report on alternate models for the delivery of solid waste collection, haulage and recycling.

# <u>Amendment to Traffic By-law – Metered Parking Increases</u>

4. Moved by L. Compton, Seconded by T. Szajewski & Carried:-

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to amend Schedule "G" to Comprehensive Traffic By-law #127-2001 to change "Half-Hour Meters" to "Two-Hour Meters" and to increase the parking meter fees from 50 cents per 60 minutes to 75 cents per 60 minutes (together with adjusting the other applicable fees and times); and

THAT Council give three readings to adopt By-law #66-2006 being a by-law to regulate parking in parking lots and structures in the City of Kenora; and

THAT public notice is hereby given that Council intends to increase metered parking fees and parking lot fees at its May 23 meeting; and further

THAT these fee increases will take effect and come into force on June 1, 2006.

#### Amendment to Traffic By-law - Set Fine Schedule

5. Moved by L. Compton, Seconded by C. Wasacase & Carried:-

THAT as recommended by the Finance & Administration Committee, authorization be hereby given for the Clerk's Office to make arrangements to increase the entire Set Fine Schedule contained on Schedule "V" of Comprehensive Traffic By-law #127-2001 as set out on the attached revised schedule; and further

THAT public notice is hereby given that Council intends to give three readings to a by-law for this purpose.



# <u> Lease Renewal – Kenora Air Service (Wharf)</u>

6. Moved by T. Szajewski, Seconded by C. Wasacase & Carried:-

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize the execution of three (3) lease agreements with Kenora Air Service Ltd. for a two year period for the purpose of leasing the Second Street Wharf/storage space, the gas pumps and line, as well as for the office.

#### Lease Renewal - Walsten Air Service (Wharf)

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize the execution of two (2) lease agreements with Walsten Air Service (1986) Ltd. for a two year period for the purpose of leasing the Second Street Wharf and storage space, as well as for the gas pumps and line.

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize the execution of a land lease renewal between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Walsten Air Service (1986) Ltd. for a further two year term to May 31, 2008.

# Gas Tank Storage Lease Renewal - Kenora Air & Walsten Air

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize a further five year lease agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Kenora Air Service Ltd., and Walsten Air Service (1986) Ltd. for gas storage tanks.

THAT the appropriate By-law authorizing the 2006 Solid Waste Utility Budget be approved.

#### Appropriation from Tax Rebates/Write Offs Reserve

THAT Council authorize an appropriation from the Tax Rebates / Write Offs Reserve in the amount of \$61,333.18, representing the City's share of tax reductions related to a 2005 vacancy rebate on a major industrial property within the City; and

THAT in accordance with Notice By-Law Number 14-2003, public notice is hereby given that Council intends to amend the 2006 Budget for this purpose at its May 23 meeting; and further

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to amend the operating budget to authorize the related appropriation from the Tax Rebates / Write Offs Reserve.

#### Exemption to Noise By-law - Agricultural Fair

THAT Council of the City of Kenora hereby authorizes the Kenora Agricultural Society to hold its 95th Annual Fair at the Kenora Recreation Centre; and further

THAT authorization be hereby given for an exemption under Noise By-law 40-2001 to the Select Shows Midway to operate until 12:00 midnight from August 3 to August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

# Student Membership Rate - Kenora Recreation Centre

THAT Council of the City of Kenora receives the recommendation from the Leisure Services Committee, approving the rate of \$135.00 for a summer membership for post secondary students on a trial basis for 2006, expiring Labour Day (May 1, 2006 to September 4, 2006); and

THAT this promotion be reviewed in the fall of 2006 to determine if it should be incorporated into the tariff of fees schedule; and

THAT the new rates take effect immediately; and further

THAT Council approves the Recreation Centre Management the authorization to implement promotional and marketing specials.

# Fee Structure - Harbourfront South Parking Lot

THAT Council of the City of Kenora accepts and approves the revised parking rates and parking options at the Harbourfront South Parking Lot; and further

THAT Council incorporates the following parking fee structure into the Parking Lot By-Law: -



#### • Harbourfront South Parking Lot.

- \$0.75 cents per hour for daily rates;

- \$7.00 per day (plus applicable taxes) for overnight parking. Maximum of 8 sites to be designated for overnight parking;

- \$49.60 (plus applicable taxes) per month; and further

THAT in accordance with By-law #14-2003, notice is hereby given that Council intends to adopt the above rates by by-law at its May 23 meeting.

#### **Common Ground Report**
