- To stop up, close and sell the lane or parts thereof described as Parts 2, 3, 4 and 5 on Plan 23R-11262;
- To accept the transfer of Part 2 on Plan 11273 to be incorporated into the City's Road allowance for Wyder Road;
- To provide that the Line Fences Act does not apply to all or any part of the City of Kenora and for the regulation, erection and maintenance of fences in The City of Kenora.
