2. Economic Development – Status report Jennifer Rasmussen presented highlights from her report.	
<b>3. Zoning By-law Amendment – Double fronting yards</b> The "Accessory buildings, uses or structures" provision of Zoning By-law 160-2004 is intended to control development on property while recognizing that storage and recreational structures are important and/or necessary for the property owner to enhance the use of their property.	
Section 5.1.1(4) states that no accessory building or structure shall be built closer to the street than the main building is to that street. The intent of the by-law is to ensure that detached accessory buildings are not permitted in front of the building of principle use to the property.	
This section of the by-law provides a problem for owners of rural acreages who have constructed their principle use building (home or shop) set back further than the required front yard. So that if the residence is built $\frac{1}{2}$ km from the road, the property owner would not be permitted to construct an accessory garage between the existing principle use building and the road.
