#### **Call to Order**

Mayor Compton called the meeting to order and Councillor McCann read the Prayer.

## **Confirmation of Minutes**

WHEREAS the volunteer community-based organization, namely the Kawartha Lakes Health Care Initiative whose mission is to recruit and retain primary health care professionals in the City of Kawartha Lakes is restricted in its mission as they observe family physicians closing their practice and taking advantage of salaried positions in local hospitals and emergency departments where these same family physicians are provided with enhanced remuneration and lifestyle opportunities;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Kenora hereby supports the City of Kawartha Lakes in requesting the Minister of Health to review this situation and to offer effective incentives to Health Care Professionals in Ontario to continue to practice comprehensive, community-based family medicine; and

THAT this resolution be sent to the Premier of Ontario, Dalton McGuinty, George Smitherman, Minister of Health and Long Term Care, and Howard Hampton, M.P.P.
