DELEGATIONS

Doug Lafreniere, of Jarnel Contracting described potential development of now-vacant land for a Tim Horton's outlet. The location is between Lakeview Drive and Street A in the Norman area. There is an application to add a drive through facility as a use to the current Highway Commercial designation. A draft traffic study was circulated for review and the lot described according to a survey which was recently completed. Mr. Lafreniere has been in contact with the neighbours to the east to discuss possible reconfiguration of both properties, if the rezoning application is approved and Jarnel purchases the property.

Discussion took place with respect to access possibilities and challenges. Mr. Lafreniere has consulted with the City's Operations department with respect to those challenges and an existing storm drain located on the west side of the property.

- 2) A Schedule to the Transfer/Deed of Land form on which is set out the entire legal description of the parcel(s) in question and containing the names of the parties indicated on page 1 of the Transfer/Deed of Land form be provided.
- 3) Three original copies (not photocopies) of the reference plan of survey, bearing the Land Registry Office registration number and signatures as evidence of deposit therein, and illustrating the parcel(s) to which the consent approval relates and which must show in general the same area and dimensions as the sketch forming part of the application be provided.
- 4) That the subject property, 34 Wyder Road, CON 2M PT LOT 6 BEING RP;23R7681 PT 1 PCL 37980, be rezoned to RR Rural.
- 5) That a letter be received from the Northwestern Health Unit indicating that the sewage systems on both properties meet their requirements.
- 6) That the severed lot, to be transferred to McCardle, be tied to the property described as CON 2M LOT 6 W PT DES KR 208;PART 11 PCL24972 AND;RP 23R8311 PT 3 PCL 39130 by section 118 of the *Land Titles Act*.

If the conditions to consent approval are not fulfilled within one year of the date on this letter and the applicant is still interested in pursuing the proposal, a new application will be required.
