Amending Agreement – Kenora Golf Club Property

1. Moved by W. Cuthbert, Seconded by C. Van Walleghem & Carried:-

THAT the Council of the City of Kenora adopts a by-law to authorize the execution of an amending Agreement regarding golf course properties as follows:

- 1. To release Part 1, 23R11347 from "Golf Course Designation" for the purposes of realignment of the Pine Portage Road;
- 2. To add the "Golf Course Designation" to Part 4, 23R3712, except for Parts 2 & 3, 23R9042; and further

THAT the Mayor and Clerk on behalf of the City are hereby empowered to execute the amending Agreement and all other documents and do all things necessary to complete this transaction.

Schedule N - "Prohibited Turning Movements"

Schedule O - "Stop Signs at Intersections" and

Schedule P - "Yield Intersections;" and further
