3. Accounts Payable History-Waushushk Onigum First Nation <u>Discussion:</u>

Waushushk Onigum First Nation Fire Protection Account with the City of Kenora Fire and Emergency Services is in arrears. City of Kenora's Collection division reports that this account is to receive payment on 10 January 2008. Council has instructed the City of Kenora Fire and Emergency Services to notify Waushushk Onigum First Nation that this Fire Protection Agreement is in jeopardy of being terminated as per the terms set out in the Fire Protection Agreement if payment is not received.

4. Burning Permits
