BACKGROUND.

Further to Councillor Poirier submitting his letter of resignation from Council effective July 31, 2009, The Municipal Act requires that Council shall at its next regular meeting, declare the seat vacant. Once the seat is declared vacant, Council has 60 days to decide how to proceed with filling the vacancy, i.e. appointment or by-election and this matter will be addressed in my follow-up report for August to review the options.

In the meantime, Councillor Poirier's resignation will be formally received with regret at the July 13 meeting.
