Through the Recreational Infrastructure Canada (RInC) Program in Ontario, the governments of Canada and Ontario have committed to supporting upgrades to community recreation facilities over the next two years. The Recreational Infrastructure Canada (RInC) Program in Ontario and is designed to support the upgrading and renewal of recreational facilities in communities that can be completed by March 31, 2011.
