SUMMARY OF PLANNED ACTIVITIES for 2010

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: That several of the planned activities for 2010 are scheduled for the North Pavillion Promenade in the small tent. According to Revitalization plans, the area known as the North Pavilion Promenade will be under construction and not be available for any planned activities, <u>THUS</u> all off the events will have to be `shunted to the South Parking Lot or seek alternative locations beyond the Harbourfront.

The Kenora Assembly of Resources has met recently and the topic of Harbourfront events was discussed and the potential implications during the Second stage of Revitalization on the Harbourfront. These are the recommendations made at the meeting:

Recommendation # 1

The large tent remain `Status Quo on the South Parking lot for 2010 To facilitate all of the tentatively planned activities.
Justification: Difficult to make large tent ready between events and committal to having parking in the large tent in readiness for 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Recommendation # 2

That the small tent on the North Pavilion Promenade not be erected to facilitate any of the requested activities for this area in 2010. All requested and planned activities for the small tent on the North Pavillion promenade (Small tent) be moved to the South Parking Lot (Large tent).

Recommendation #3

It was recommended by the Directors of the Kenora Assembly Resources that there be **NO** parking of vehicles under the large tent on the South Parking Lot.

Recommendation # 4

That during phase two of Revitalization, that the Green Belt on Lakeview Drive should not be disturbed for any long periods of time during construction.

Recommendation # 5

That the topic of Harbourfront Parking be addressed at a special meeting called by the Harbourfront Committee for all concerned individuals, event organizers and business enterprise being affected with the parking on the Harbourfront and specific to the large tent being erected on the South Parking Lot for long extended periods of time to facilitate the numerous events.

Recommendation # 6

That the Coordinator of Community Events in consultation with event organizers be tasked with the responsibility of presenting a plan for the facilitation of all of the Harbourfront events at alternate locations should their be interference with events that will impede the progress of construction during phase two of Revitalization.

Recommendation # 7

At the Special meeting called by the Kenora Assembly of Resources that the topic of long Range planning be discussed as to how it will affect both future parking and events based on the planed concepts of phase two revitalization, more so on the South Parking lot.
