<p><u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> That Council of the City of Kenora gives three readings to a bylaw to ratify an agreement with Sports, Culture, and Tourism Partnership Secretariat Office Ministry Of Tourism for the City of Kenora's approved project(s) under the Recreational Infrastructure Canada (RInC) Program; and</p> <p>THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be hereby authorized to execute the Contribution Agreement; and</p> <p>THAT in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007, public notice is hereby given that Council intends to amend its 2009 Operating & Capital Budget at its October 19, 2009 meeting, with \$250,000.00 coming from Recreation Reserves to offset the cost of this capital project; and further</p> <p>THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to amend the 2009 budget for this purpose.</p>
