5. Heritage Property Tax Relief

Lisa reviewed the highlights, from her email, listing the municipalities with Heritage Tax Relief by-laws, in Ontario. Thunder Bay was cited as an example of a municipality that budgets \$25,000 for Heritage Tax Relief. They have not expended their budget yet, and surpluses have been placed in a reserve fund. Lisa indicated that the municipality generally opts for granting the rebate back to the owner, in the form of a grant. It was suggested that a draft by-law, and budget, be prepared for consideration by the Heritage Committee.
