Re: Community Policing Partnerships (CPP) Program

Recommendation:

THAT Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize the execution of an agreement between the Minister of Public Safety and Security, the City of Kenora, and the Kenora Police Services Board with respect to the Community Policing Partnerships (CPP) Program and the CPP Criminal Intelligence Initiative.

Background:

The Ministry has established the Community Policing Partnerships (CPP) Program as part of the government's commitment to make Ontario communities safer by enhancing police visibility.

The Ministry wishes to continue to fund the Board by granting to the Municipality for the purpose of maintaining the increased number of sworn officers of the OPP Kenora for enhanced police visibility.

The term of the contract is April 1, 2010 and shall expire on March 31, 2012 according to Schedule "A" of the Agreement.

Budget:

The revenue from these programs has been included in the 2010 Municipal Budget.
