Recommendation:

That Council give three readings to a by-Law authorizing the Council of the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with Pellatt United Firefighters Inc. to provide Radio Circuits, Radio Licenses, and maintenance of the Kenora and Area Fire Communications System as set out in Schedule "A" as attached to this report; and further

That By-Law 46-2004 be and is hereby repealed.

Background:

The former Town of Kenora, now the City of Kenora has provided Fire Dispatch for Pellatt United Firefighters since 1984 to the March of 2009. With Fire Communications moving to the Central Ambulance Communication Centre in March of 2009 the costs and obligations for the Kenora and Area Fire Communications System have changed. The details of these changes are set out in Schedule "A" as attached.
