RE: Anicinabe Park-Public Docking Policy By-law #57-2009-Amendment

Background:

Larry Cruikshank completed his first year of a five year contract to maintain Anicinabe Park. The Council of the City of Kenora recently accepted the year-end report regarding Anicinabe Park and the recommendation from the Anicinabe Park Committee to amend Bylaw #57-2009, Public Docking Policy, regarding free daily parking and no overnight parking. The amendment to include Anicinabe Park as a facility which is available for free daily docking and where free daily docking is made available, there shall be no overnight parking.

Recommendation:

THAT the Council of the City of Kenora amend Bylaw #57-2009, a by-law which provides a policy for public boat docking within the municipality at a variety of locations and for the monitoring and enforcement of such docking.

AND THAT the Section 4. <u>Docking – Facilities</u> of By-law #57-2009 be amended to include Anicinabe Park as a facility that is available for free daily docking by the municipality,

AND THAT there shall be no overnight parking at Anicinabe Park.
