**Re: Traffic Regulation By-Law 127-2001 – Amend Schedule “K” –
Disabled Parking – Main Street South – Temporary for Election**

Recommendation:

That Council give three readings to a by-law to amend City of Kenora Traffic Regulation By-law 127-2001 to include the following amendments to Schedule “K” - Disabled Parking Spaces on Streets and Highways – Main Street South:-

Column 1 STREET	Column 2 LOCATION	Column 3 SIDE	Column 4 TYPE OF PARKING	Column 5 # OF SPACES
ADD Main Street South	From 40.8 metres north of McClellan Avenue, northerly for 7.3 metres; and	East	Parallel	1

That this amendment be implemented on “a temporary basis only” for the period starting October 4, 2010 to and including October 25, 2010 to cover the duration of the Municipal Election.

Background:

In preparation for the Municipal Election a barrier free parking space is required on Main Street South in front of City Hall, while the Revision Centre (Council Chambers) is open to the public, to provide a more convenient location for electors attending Council Chambers, in keeping with legislation for ‘an accessible election mandate.’

It is recommended the parking space closest to the entrance into the City Hall parking lot be established (so a curb cut-out is not required), from Main Street South, and be converted to a barrier free space, on a temporary basis only.

It is further recommended that the barrier free space be “temporary” starting October 4, 2010 and removed by October 26, 2010.

This change will require the following amendment to Traffic Regulation By-Law #127-2001 - Schedule “K” Disabled Parking on Streets and Highways:
