Agreement

Recommendation

That Council give three readings to a by-law to enter into an agreement with the Ontario Electronic Stewardship to provide payment to the City of Kenora for the collection and storage of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment to be picked up from the Kenora Waste Transfer Facility.

Background:

The City of Kenora recently held a one day collection event for old electronic components at the Kenora Waste Transfer Facility on Saturday, May 29, 2010.

It is proposed that the City waste transfer site would be a collection depot for Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE).

In general the City will collect and store WEEE materials and the Ontario Electronic Stewardship (OES) will make arrangements to pick up and pay for all shipping costs. The OES will pay the City of Kenora \$200.00 per tonne for the collection and storage service.

In order to receive funding it is necessary for the City to enter into an agreement with OES. A copy of the attached agreement has been forwarded to legal counsel for review.
