Take Notice that as required under Notice By-law #144-2007 Council intends to adopt the following at its March 15, 2010 meeting:

- An appropriation of \$20,000 from the Insurance Reserves to complete a Risk Management project
 - Amendment of a by-law to establish increased limousine rates
- Amendment to the use of Veteran's plates in the City of Kenora to allow these plates free parking for the permitted time limits per meter for three specific days per year being: June 6th (D-Day), September 17th (Anniversary of the Battle of Britain) and November 11th (Remembrance Day)

Information on Voting by Mayor & Council under The Municipal Act, 2001

243. Except as otherwise provided, every member of a council shall have one vote;

245. Any question on which there is a tie vote shall be deemed to be lost, except where otherwise provided by any Act;

246. (1) If a member present at a meeting at the time of a vote requests immediately before or after the taking of the vote that the vote be recorded, each member present, except a member who is disqualified from voting by any Act, shall announce his or her vote openly and the clerk shall record each vote;

(2) A failure to vote under subsection (1) by a member who is present at the meeting at the time of the vote and who is qualified to vote shall be deemed to be a negative vote.
