- Re: Utility Consumption for 2009

## **Recommendation:**

That Council of the City of Kenora receives the information on utility consumption for the Kenora Recreation Centre and the Keewatin Memorial Arena for the year 2009.

# Background:

Staff has been making a concerted effort to improve and track energy consumption at the Keewatin Memorial Arena and the Kenora Recreation Centre. The goal was to improve overall operating cost to these facilities over the next few years. A portion of projects, included in both our operating and RInC grant, have now been completed and another portion is scheduled to be completed this summer. The following is a list of our findings to date:

# Savings in 2009 \$ 4,390

- Adjustments to gas fired hot water tanks.
- Removal of infra red heaters on walking track.
- Installation of instantaneous hot water heaters.

#### Increase in 2009 \$11,273

- Increase in utility costs: \$0.0062/kWh to \$0.0065/kWh
- Increase in network distribution charges:\$1.5790000 to \$1.721100/kVA (demand)
- Increase in conn. transmission charges: \$0.429900 to \$0.451400/kVA (demand)
- Increase in distribution charges: \$1.226200 to \$1.237200/kVA (demand)
- Installation of unit heaters (walking track)
- Positive changes should be noticed in 2010 with the changing of Metal Halide lighting to Induction Lighting located in the Arena Bowl.
- Positive changes should be noticed in 2010 with the installation of some sensory lighting for the janitor's closets, storage areas, and washrooms.

#### Savings in 2009 \$45

Little change noted in water consumption. 

> Positive changes in consumption should be noticed in 2010 with upgrades to the ice plant completed end of December 2009.

# Savings in 2009 \$ 1,974

- Better maintenance practices (taps leaking & flushometer change-outs).
- Better management and consistency in pool chemistry

#### Increase in 2009 \$ 5,784

- Water line ruptured under Ice slab. Repair completed end of December 2009. (\$ 12,000 over budget for 4 months due to water line leaking).
- Missing 2 bills (June & July 2008).

#### <u>Summary</u>

Gas at the Kenora Thistle Arena had an annual saving of \$ 4,390 or 31%.

Water at the Kenora Thistle Arena had an annual saving of \$45 or 1%.

Hydro for the Kenora Recreation Centre (entire complex) was over the 2008 costs by \$11,273 or 6%.

Gas for the Pool and Fitness Centre had an annual saving of \$11,314 or 14%. Water for the Pool and Fitness Centre had an annual saving of \$1,974 or 17%.

Gas at the Keewatin Memorial Arena had an annual saving of \$4,600 or 17%

Hydro at the Keewatin Memorial Arena had an annual saving of \$8,535 or 18%.

Water at the Keewatin Memorial Arena was over the 2008 costs by \$5,784 or 28%.
