Re: Kenora Rotary New Year's Eve Event

Recommendation:

THAT approval be given for the Kenora Recreation Centre to remain open from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm December 31st, 2010 for families and individuals to participate in recreation on the New Year's Eve Statutory Holiday; and further,

THAT the City of Kenora waives the facility rentals fee for this purpose; and further,

THAT all staffing and additional costs for this day be covered by the Kenora Rotary Club.

Background:

The Rotary Club of Kenora was very happy with the outcome from 2009 Family New Year's Event and very proud that they could provide healthy New Year's Eve activities for over 500 people attended the celebration.

The Rotary Club of Kenora is once again planning to host the Family New Year event and is looking to the City of Kenora for assistance with this Endeavour. Last year the event provided families with access to the pool (including slide and hot tub), arena and fitness centre as well as free sleigh rides outside.

The Rotary Club of Kenora also provided the first 250 people with free hot dogs and hot chocolate. The recreation centre was open from 4-8 p.m. with the club covering the rental costs, staffing costs, food costs and sleigh ride fees. Many of those attending thanked the Rotarians for putting on the event, informing them that they would not have been able to partake in the event had Rotary not covered the costs.

Recreation and healthy living is becoming more and more important, especially with our youth. The availability of healthy opportunities for children and families needs to be a priority. The Rotary Club of Kenora would like to request the donation of the pool and arena rental fees for the 2010 Rotary Family New Year event. The Rotary Club will cover the costs of the staff wages and will provide free sleigh rides, hot dogs and hot chocolate to the attendees.
