## City Council Committee Report

**Re: Amendment to Traffic Regulation By-Law 127-2001 – No Parking –  
Tow Away Zone – Erie Street**

### **Recommendation:**

**That** the City of Kenora Traffic Regulation By-law 127-2001 be amended to include the following addition to Schedule "B" – No Parking Area – Tow Away Zone – Erie Street;

### **Add:**

<u>Column 1</u> STREET/HIGHWAY	<u>Column 2</u> LOCATION	<u>Column 3</u> SIDE	<u>Column 4</u> TIME
Erie Street	From Eighth Street westerly for 40 metres	Both	Anytime

### **Background:**

The Roads Department is requesting a no parking tow away zone be applied to both sides of Erie Street at the Eighth Street junction in order to control congestion created by parked cars. In the winter the narrowed roadway makes it difficult for snow plough and removal equipment to clear the street.

Grader Operators feel the area is dangerous for negotiating equipment and for school buses traveling that route to St. Louis School due to the narrowness and congestion. Implementing the proposed restriction would keep the approach to the intersection open.

I recommend that Schedule "B" of the Traffic Regulation By-Law #127-2001 be amended as follows:

### **Add:**

<u>Column 1</u> STREET/HIGHWAY	<u>Column 2</u> LOCATION	<u>Column 3</u> SIDE	<u>Column 4</u> TIME
Erie Street	From Eighth Street westerly for 40 metres	Both	Anytime
