Background:

The Lake of the Woods Development Commission was established by Council in 2007 to implement the City of Kenora's Economic Development Plan. Council has one representative on the Commission's Board of Directors and one member of council sits on each of the Commission's three standing committees to ensure that Council is informed and involved in the work of the Commission.

The purpose of the monthly updates to Council are to ensure that all members of Council are fully informed of the work of the Commission and the progress on the implementation of the City of Kenora's Economic Development Plan.

In addition to these monthly updates, Council receives a quarterly report from members of the Commission's Executive Committee as per the Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the Commission.

The attached report is the August 2010 report. The report focuses on the work of the three standing committees of the Lake of the Woods Development Commission: Tourism, Education & Training and Business Development.
