Re: Discharge of Firearms By-Law - Request for Exemption

Recommendation:

That Council acknowledges the Youth Ministry entitled "Centershot Ministries" operating under The Way Christian Fellowship Inc. held at the former Our Lady of the Valley School; and,

That a component of the Ministry is the practice of indoor archery; and,

That Council grants The Way Christian Fellowship Inc. an exemption to By-Law #148-2010 Section 6; and further,

That three readings be given to a by-law for this purpose.

Background:

The City of Kenora has received a request from the organization *The Way Christian Fellowship Inc.*, for an exemption to By-Law #148-2010, being a By-Law to regulate the discharge of firearms, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows, long-bows or any class or type thereof.

The Pastor runs a Youth Ministry entitled "Centershot Ministries" and leases space in the former Our Lady of the Valley School (owned by Kenora/Patricia Family Services) for church meetings and indoor archery. The program was initiated in 2009 and would like to run from September 25^{th} , 2010 until June 4^{th} , 2011.

Section 6.2 of the Firearms By-Law #148-2010 requires that exemptions to the By-Law be made in writing and must set out the reasons for the proposed exemption and the location and time of the exemption.

Pastor Bill Cowan has submitted a written request for an exemption stating that the archery component would be run indoors for recreational purposes at the former Our Lady of the Valley School on Saturday afternoons from 1:00 p.m. until 5:30 p.m. and on Sundays following their worship service until 2:00 p.m.

I recommend that Council grant *The Way Christian Fellowship Inc.* an exemption to By-Law # 148-2010.
