Re: Recycle Haulage and CIF Project #288 - Agreements

#### **Recommendation:**

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora has accepted funding under the Continuous Improvement Fund (CIF) for a cooperative recycling haulage service with the City of Dryden;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute a Haulage Agreement between The Corporation of the City of Kenora and The City of Dryden, in accordance with the terms and conditions therein and affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
- THAT the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement between The Corporation of the City of Kenora and The Continuous Improvement Fund Project #288, in accordance with the terms and conditions therein and affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
- 3. **THAT** these by-laws shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.

## Background:

On July 12, 2010, adopted under Resolution #25, approval was given for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with the City of Dryden to accept payment for haulage of their recycle material to Winnipeg, Manitoba, as required. The next step is for the City of Kenora and the City of Dryden to enter into a formal agreement for the service. The attached agreement has been reviewed and approved by the City of Kenora Solicitor and the City of Dryden.

Also adopted under Resolution #25 was approval for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with the Waste Diversion Ontario (WDO) and Stewardship Ontario for funding under the Continuous Improvement Fund (CIF). It is now

necessary for the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with the Continuous Improvement Fund to undertake Project #288 – Cooperative Recycling Haulage.

Project #288 provides 50% funding to Kenora to purchase a tractor trailer unit to haul the recycle material to Winnipeg and 50% funding for the City of Dryden to purchase a self packing recycle trailer.
