Reading of Public Notices

Take Notice that as required under Notice By-law #144-2007, Council intends to adopt the following items at this Special Meeting of Council:

- To delegate authority to the CAO for land matters
- To amend the Capital budget for Fit & Finish in the Fire Station Reserves in the amount of \$50,000
- Approve contingency allocation in the Fire Station Reserves to a maximum of \$100,000
- Accept a tender for the Matheson Street and Main Street Wharfs upgrades
- Declare 14th Street North lands surplus

Council Authority delegated to CAO for Land Matters

That Council hereby gives three readings to By-law 161-2010 – A By-law to Delegate Council's authority to acquire and dispose of land in certain circumstances, in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora.

Budget Amendment for Fire & Emergency Services Facility- Fit and Finish 2. Moved by C. Drinkwalter, Seconded by D. McCann & Carried:- **That** Council hereby approves an amendment to the 2010 capital plan to increase the total estimated cost of the Emergency Service Facility to include Fit and Finish; and further

That Council approve the Fit and Finish budget as identified in the Fire Station Reserve in the amount of \$138,000.00 plus net impact of applicable taxes; and further

That Council approve an additional allocation to the Fit and Finish budget as identified in the Fire Station Reserve in the amount of \$50,000.00 plus net impact of applicable taxes; and further

That in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007, public notice is hereby given that Council intends to amend its 2010 Capital Plan by by-law at its September 8th meeting.

Budget Amendment for Fire & Emergency Services Contingency Allocation 3. Moved by D. McCann, Seconded by C. Drinkwalter & Carried:-

That Council hereby approves an amendment to the 2010 capital plan to increase the total estimated cost of the Emergency Service Facility to include the Contingency Allocation; and further

That Council approve the Contingency Allocation as identified in the Fire Station Reserve to an upset limit in the amount of \$100,000.00 plus net impact of applicable taxes; and further

That in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007, public notice is hereby given that Council intends to amend its 2010 Capital Plan by by-law at its September 8th meeting.

Main & Matheson Street Wharfs Upgrade Tender 4. Moved by C. Van Walleghem, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

That the following tenders, for the Matheson Street & Main Street Wharf Upgrade, (HST extra), be received;

That the bid submitted by LMD Contracting, Kenora, Ontario, in the amount of \$731,275 (HST extra) be hereby accepted.

Municipal Lands Declared Surplus

That the exact dimensions and description of the property will be determined by plan of survey per the instruction of the City of Kenora; and

That in accordance with Notice By-law #14-2003, arrangements be made to advertise the sale of the subject lands for a three-week period; and further

That once the advertising process has been completed, and the agreement between the Kenora District Services Board and the City of Kenora is executed, Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize the transfer of land to the Kenora District Services Board, per the terms of the agreement.
