Recommendation:

That Council of the City of Kenora acknowledge the 5th Annual Lewis Mackenzie Order of Canada ICROSS National Honour Ride to be held July 29^{th} , July 30^{th} & July 31^{st} , 2011; and further,

That approvals be granted as outlined below in conjunction with the above noted Special event:

That authorization be granted for the Canadian Veteran Motorcycle Units (CAV) to hold a Flag Raising Ceremony at City Hall at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday July 30th, 2011; and,

That approval be granted for parking of the motorcycles during the flag raising ceremony in the City Hall parking lot and the metered parking spots in front of City Hall from 9:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.; and,

That authorization be granted for the Canadian Veteran Motorcycle Units (CAV) to hold a Memorial Service at the Lake of the Woods Cemetery on Saturday, July 30th at 11 a.m.; and further,

That general vehicular traffic be prohibited in the Cemetery from 10:30 a.m.– 12:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 30th, 2011, during the Memorial Service.

Background:

The Canadian Army Veterans is a group which formed in 2003 by Canadian Veterans whose common bond was service to one's country, as well as the fact they are avid motorcyclists. This is a national brotherhood of Canadian Army, Air Force & Navy veterans and supporters. Please see the attached information sheet on CAV.

The CAV is planning their fifth annual Lewis Mackenzie Order of Canada ICROSS National Honour Ride in Kenora, aptly called Rat Portage Rendezvous, during the August long weekend. The group is working in partnership with both Legions, the police force, & the Parks Department. A parade permit has been issued. They are expecting 60-75 veterans on motorcycles. The itinerary for the weekend is attached.

- General vehicular traffic be prohibited in the Cemetery from 10:30 12:30 on Saturday, July 30th, 2011, during the Memorial Service.
