## Re: Tops and Bottoms Regatta - 2011

#### **Recommendation:**

**That** the Council of the City of Kenora hereby acknowledges the Kenora Rowing Club's Tops and Bottoms Regatta to be held July 22<sup>nd</sup> and July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 on Rabbit Lake; and,

**That** the following approvals be granted as outlined below in conjunction with this event:

- 1. A variance be granted for the motor size on Rabbit Lake as set out by Bylaw No. 153-2005 (as there is a need to operate 25-50 h.p. motors to keep up to the racing boats to ensure their safety on the water for the event).
- 2. The event buoys to be placed in the water two to three (2–3) days prior to the event, and to be removed the following week by the Kenora Rowing Club.

## Background:

The Kenora Rowing Club is hosting the Tops and Bottoms Regatta on Rabbit Lake on Friday and Saturday, July  $22^{nd}$  &  $23^{rd}$ , 2011.

The following approvals are requested;

- 1. Request to grant a variance for the boat motor size on Rabbit Lake, set by Jaffray Melick By-Law No. 833, passed 17 November 1981. The official boats need to be 25-50 h.p. to keep up to the racing boats to ensure their safety on the water.
- Permission to place course lanes in the water two to three (2 3) days prior to the event and to remove in the following week. The buoys float, allowing swimmers, canoeists, kayakers & motorboats safe access to the lake.
