Re: Municipal Docks and Wharves By-law

Recommendation:

That Council give three readings to a by-law to regulate the use of waterfront properties with docking facilities as well as water lots utilized for boat anchorages; and further

That By-law Number 9-2010 with respect to a Municipal Docking Policy be hereby repealed.

Background:

The Corporation of the City of Kenora owns numerous waterfront properties with docking facilities as well as water lots utilized for boat anchorages and in 2009 it was decided the City would look at managing these docks and wharves as opposed to the past practice of tendering out this service.

In 2009 a general regulation Docking Policy was put in place, but it is now necessary for a comprehensive municipal by-law be adopted for enforcement purposes in conjunction with a Set Fine Schedule to better manage and enforce dock usage within the City of Kenora.

The draft by-law has been reviewed by legal counsel and arrangements will be made following the adoption of the by-law to proceed with the approval of a Set Fine Schedule to cover contravention of the by-law.
