Re: Buck Matiowski for Farmers Market, Ukrainian Literary Society

Variance to Sign By-law 115-2010

Recommendation:

That Council of the City of Kenora refuses the request for a variance from Sign By-law 115-2010 to permit a trailer mounted sign at property at 1010 Highway 17 East for the following reasons:

- Creates a driver distraction for motorists on approach to the intersection of Highway 17 East and Fifth Street South,
- The location of a temporary sign does not protect and enhance the aesthetic qualities and visual character of the City.

Background:

Buck Matiowski, on behalf of the Farmers Market and Ukrainian Literary Society, has applied to locate a temporary sign, trailer mounted, at property located at 1010 Highway 17 East. This property is the location of a vacant industrial building between Dingwall Ford and A & W.

There are several areas already approved, which do not require permission for use by non-profit groups:

- 1) Hill abutting Lakeview Drive and CPR mainline, west of roundabout
- 2) Retaining wall at South end of Bernier Drive
- 3) Road Allowance at corner of Railway Street and Tenth Avenue South.

The intent of the Sign By-law is to regulate the location and number of signs within the City. The Planning Department does not recommend the use of an unused property as a location for signage as it does not enhance the aesthetic qualities and visual character of the area.

The Operations Manager and Road Supervisor have concerns with respect to driver distraction.
